A warm welcome to everyone joining us at St Mary Magdalen this week, especially if you are here for the first time or visiting. On the next page of this newsletter you'll find all the essential information you might need for this morning's service.

CONNECTING WITH OUR COMMUNITY: OPENING THE CHURCH FOR RIDE AND STRIDE.

On Saturday 14th September we are opening the Church building to our local community and to receive visitors taking part in the annual 'Ride and Stride' event to raise money through sponsorship for the Leicestershire Historic Churches Trust (LHCT). This important local charity makes grants to churches for repairs and improvements, and we are hoping that our Spire Appeal might be a beneficiary!

In order to welcome our visitors we need a rota of volunteers to keep a watchful eye on the Church, to sign visitors in and to give them simple refreshments. Please do consider if you can help out at any time from 10am through to 6pm and sign the sheet on the noticeboard at the back of the church. We particularly need help in the space from 10am to 2pm.

You might also like to consider taking part in Ride and Stride yourself, visiting some local churches and raising money through sponsorship for LHCT. Half of any money you raise comes back to St Mary's and half goes to the Trust. Full details are at the back of the church on the noticeboard, or please talk to Flick Titley and Adrian Jones for more information.

ABOUT OUR SERVICES

- Our worship follows the printed order of service and the readings and hymns are included in the booklet.
- Large print versions are available from the sidespersons (the welcomers at the door). If you are using a hearing aid, please switch it to the T position so as to make best use of the hearing loop system.
- It is traditional to stand for the hymns and some of the prayers and readings, but if this is difficult for you then please do remain seated and comfortable.
- In the entrance area are toilets, and there is a crèche area at the back of the church. As the main 10am service is for all ages, there is no Sunday Club for the children this week.
- As part of the 8.00am and 11.30am services we share Communion together and everyone is invited to come forwards to receive bread and wine as we remember the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. If you would prefer to come for a blessing then simply carry the service booklet with you.
- You are welcome to join Adrian for a short time of prayer before the main service: 9.30-9.45am at the front of the Lady Chapel (the chapel on the left).

Please talk to the sidespersons if you have any other questions and do please stay after the 10.00 am service for tea or coffee and introduce yourself to some of us.


