

Memorial Benches

Memorial Benches are an attractive and enduring way to remember a loved one as well as being a valuable contribution towards benefitting the natural and built environment allowing loved ones and strangers to stop, rest and ponder.

There are a limited number of spaces within St Mary's Church Yard for such benches.

Management of benches needs to follow certain principles

-Material and construction of benches must meet standards for durability, quality and environmental sustainability. As such certified sustainable hardwood is the desired preference

-All new benches with details of construction material, desired location and inscription of the plaque must be approved by the incumbent on behalf of the PCC

-The donor of the bench are responsible for purchase and placing of the bench

-Benches will need upkeep maintenance and repair which remain the responsibility of the person/s who donated the bench. Once donated, it is not expected that the donor will remove their bench despite remaining responsible for its upkeep.

-If in the event that the bench requires repair or is damaged or deemed unsafe or unsightly, the PCC and incumbent reserve the right to either repair, replace, secure or remove the bench. Where appropriate, efforts will be made to contact the donor. Please leave contact details below.
